As a brief summary, the importance of reducing the consumption of irrigation water was discussed, with a study of the irrigation areas which would allow us, in the future, to maintain the maximum number of green areas on the resort, faced with a possible reduction in water flow from the Valdelentisco desalination plant.

It was intended to reduce the consumption of chlorine in pools, with the improvement and change in the filters, depending on the age and maintenance of these. This has been completed and STV were asked to report on the amount of chlorine being used on a monthly basis so we could compare consumption from before the filters were changed

The problem of trees on the resort, the damage they are causing, and the solution, continues to be looked at; the idea was proposed of a survey among owners, in order to decide on the change of trees, with the advantages and disadvantages involved. Trees that are causing damage to structures/roads have been identified. STV are going to check this list is accurate and work will start shortly to remove the ones causing damage.

Landscaping continues at a good pace on the road on the outer ring, and STV are reporting on this and putting a monthly newsletter on the website on its progress and deadlines. We also asked them to give us a plan/schedule of works for the future months on the rest of the outer ring.

In the section for AOB, the nearness of Christmas was commented on, and ideas were proposed in order to give the Resort a Christmassy feel.

Criteria were proposed in order to set the meetings for the gardening committee depending on the availability of its members, setting the next meeting for 16:00 hours on 12th February.

Finally, the idea was approved of producing a short summary of the meeting for publication and diffusion among owners, as this shows the work being carried out by the members of the committee and an interest in informing owners in order for them to be
